

Kirkby La Thorpe Parish Council

Notes of the Annual Parish Meeting of Kirkby La Thorpe held at Kirkby La Thorpe School, Church Lane, Kirkby La Thorpe, on Thursday 11th May 2017 at 7.00 pm.

Present: Cllrs White, Hipworth, Johnson, Yates, Parker and Bridgen, 1 member of the public and Mrs D Scott (Clerk),

1. Cllr White welcomed everyone to the meeting. Apologies for Absence were received from Cllr Monteith, and Cllr Harrison (NKDC)

2. The notes of the Annual Parish Meeting held on 12th May 2016 were approved as minutes, proposed by Cllr Johnson, seconded by Cllr Parker and agreed unanimously.

3. The Chairman's Report

The Chairman recounted how the Parish's year had concluded with funding successes through SRELP for the Broadband project and the St Denys' Church project, meaning that the total of £60,000 had been secured for the Parish. He thanked Mr Kirman and Rev Green and her colleagues for their perseverance with the applications.

He mentioned the Community Speedwatch, in partnership with Leasingham & Roxholm Parish Council, with SID data having thrown up some interesting details about traffic flows. It was noted that SID had recently suffered a control panel failure and was currently away for repairs under its warranty.

Although the Parish Council had a full set of Councillors during the year, he noted that Cllr Johnson was intending to resign and passed on thanks, on behalf of the Parish Council, to him for his contributions over many years.

Cllr White thanked all Councillors and the Clerk for their continued commitment.

4. Questions arising.

School Parking. A brief discussion took place in which it was noted that the Parish Council Working Group had not yet met, but neither the Police nor LCC seemed able to help with a solution. Parish Councillors felt they, and the school, had done what they could but the matter should probably be dropped for the time being.
